Information clause for contracts:

1. The administrator of your personal data is PSP Concept Sp. z o.o. with its registered office in Katowice, entered into the National Court Register under the number KRS: 0000829124, NIP 6342973878, and REGON: 385592120. 2. Providing personal data is voluntary, and their processing is carried out for the purpose and to the extent necessary for presenting an offer, establishing, shaping content, changing, or terminating an agreement, as well as its implementation and settlement. For this purpose, the Administrator may process the following personal data: names and surnames, addresses: residential, correspondence, investment, email addresses, telephone numbers, and possibly other data necessary due to the nature of the service provided or the method of its settlement.

You have the right to access your personal data, to supplement and update them, to transfer them, the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority, as well as in cases provided for by law or when they become unnecessary for the purpose for which they were collected - the right to object to the processing of personal data and the right to demand their deletion.
4. We provide appropriate technical and organizational measures to ensure the security of personal data, in particular preventing access to them by third parties or their processing in violation of the law, preventing data loss, damage, or destruction.
5. Your data will be processed until the termination of the agreement and its settlement, and until the end of the warranty period, unless other regulations require further processing.
6. Your data may be made available to appropriate state authorities at their request based on relevant legal provisions, to other persons and entities - in cases provided for by law, and possibly subcontractors - in such a case, you will be informed of this fact unless the regulations prohibit the disclosure of this information.
